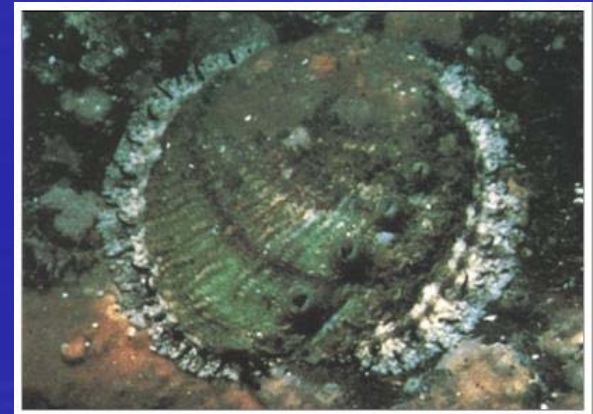

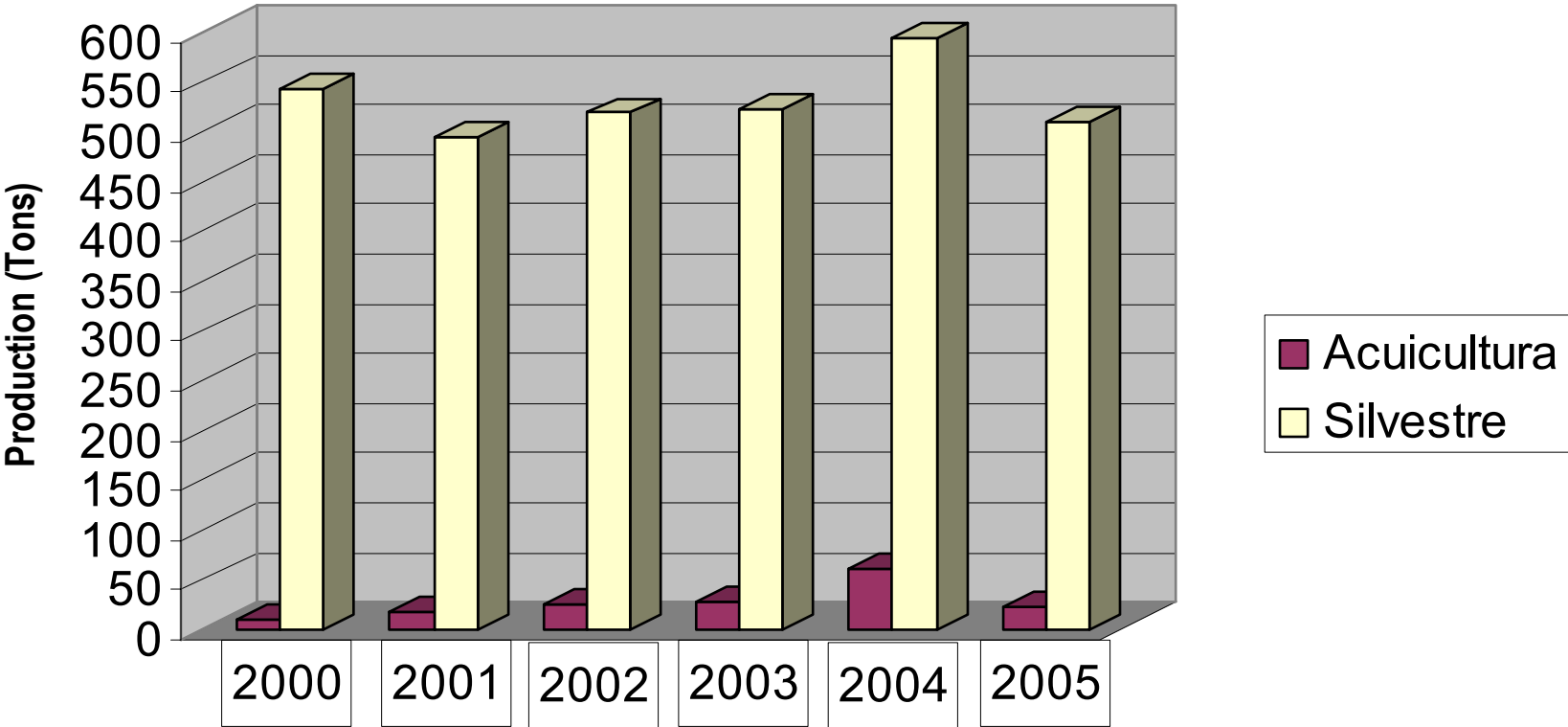
Abalone fisheries and cultured:

Red abalone (*Haliotis rufescens*), Green abalone (*Haliotis fulgens*) and Pink abalone (*Haliotis corrugata*)



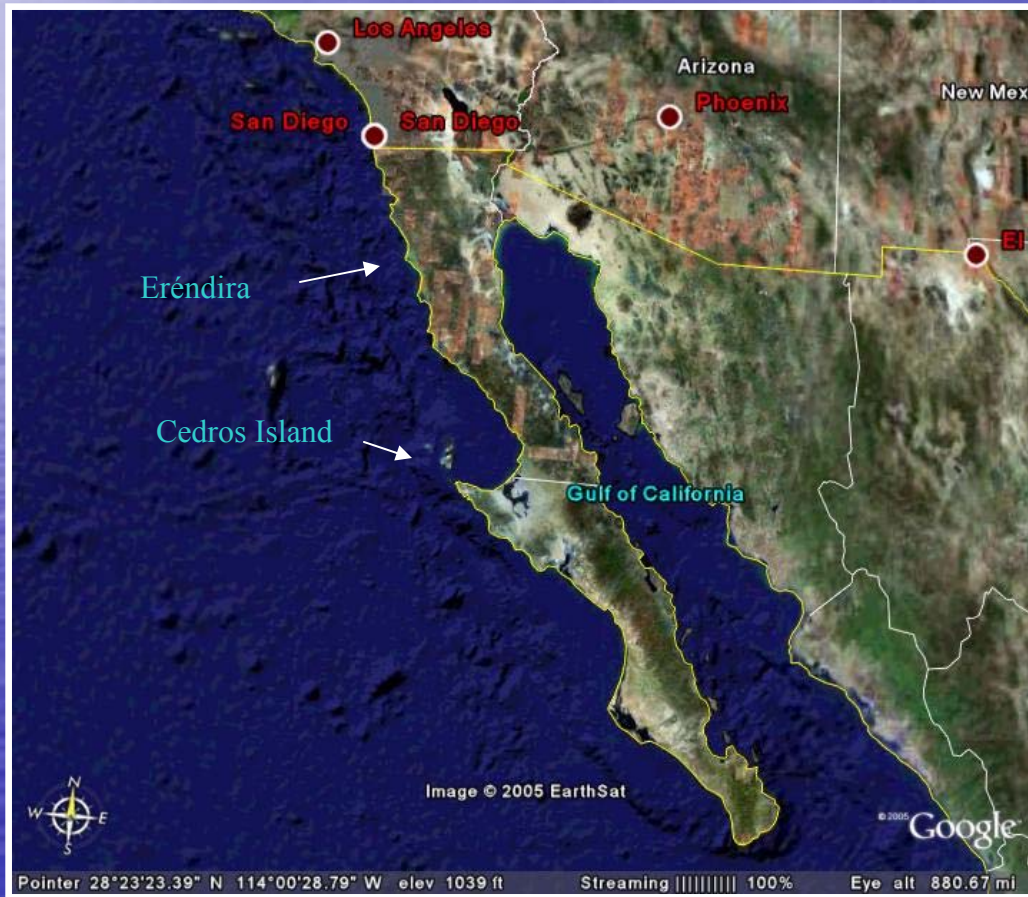
Abalone production in Mexico

Major problems in fisheries/ aquaculture:

- Poaching still a bigger problem.
- Aquaculture is considered of high risk
Not attractive
- Land property in coastal areas
- Enviromental permits long and expensive



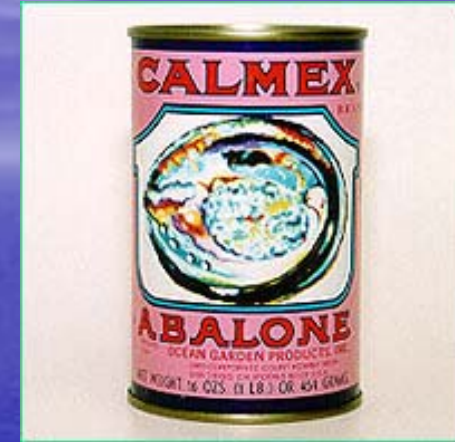
Incentives for aquaculture in Mexico:

- Reduction of electricity cost in 50% in effect from mid-2005
- Funding for development of new farms (SAGARPA) this is a new federal program.
- Currently three farms in development
- Electricity in potencial farming areas
- State BC Aquaculture loans program



Recent events in Mexico:

- Mexican Abalone CALMEX Brand sold to:
 - Aqua Tech, Acuícola Boca and Grupo Industrial Pesquero Mexicano.
- Consejo Mexicano del Abulon, AC
- Most of the producers involved in this venture.



Research and Development:

- Recirculated system seed and grow out
- Genetic programs improve seed quality
- Sanitary monitoring farms
- Broodstock conditioning specially green and pink abalone
